Recommendations from the committee will be encouraged and welcomed. However, this advisory committee is not intended to replace any of the functions of our staff, who will retain their authority regarding the day-to-day operations of the organization. In the same way, the Board of Directors maintains its authority to manage the business and property of the organization, but it seeks to increase and preserve input from stakeholders through this committee.

Regular meeting dates and further descriptions of duties, activities and topics of discussion will be determined by the committee.
