

FRONT OF HOUSE

Prepare, sell and serve our classic fresh organic popcorn, cookies, and other treats. Enjoy the show and then stay after to help with clean-up.

Ushers are also needed for our live events, such as theatrical productions or concerts, to help patrons find their seats.

BEER & WINE SALES

Servers are needed for many of our live events when we open the Art Bar for patrons. The Lincoln Theatre will reimburse for the necessary Class 12 Server Permit required to sell alcoholic beverages.

VOLUNTEER DISCLOSURE FORM
